

RULES FOR PATIENTS UNDERGOING INTRAVENOUS SEDATION IN OFFICE

- 1. Absolutely nothing to eat or drink (not even water) for six (6) hours prior to your appointment.
- 2. You must be accompanied by a responsible adult because you will not be permitted to drive for twenty-four (24) hours after the medication is administered. Your driver is required to stay in the waiting room during your procedure.**
- 3. Please wear a short sleeve shirt or top so that the surgeon can access your arm to stat the IV and administer the medication.
- 4. If you wear contact lenses, please remove them before your appointment.
- 5. If you use them, please remove lipstick and nail polish before your appointment.
- 6. If you use bronchial inhalers, please bring them with you.
- 7. If you are diabetic, please follow your prescribed medication instructions at all times.
- 8. Do not plan to return to work or operate any machinery for twelve (12) hours after your procedure.
- 9. If you are taking narcotic pain medication, do not operate a motor vehicle or other machinery/equipment.
- 10. Prior to your appointment, if you have normal/daily prescription medication(s), please take them with a very small amount of water.

**COVID-19 restrictions may require your driver to wait in the building lobby or in their car during your procedure.
